Further Professional Development Options

Learning communities

An impact project to raise achievement for HLP learners. This is a series of 3 workshops plus a self-directed impact project, including implementing the learning and research in the classroom. This is most effective in groups of 10 - 20 teachers.

Co-Delivery

One of our specialists works with the school's lead teacher to plan and deliver several lessons to challenge high potential learners. They then co-deliver professional development to other members of staff.

Mentoring

One of our specialists mentors the school's lead teacher or another member of staff in the area of challenging high potential learners over the course of two terms. This can either precede or follow a professional development session.
